**Trustees** - Trustees are working on replacing all lights in the church buildings with LED bulbs, and have asked to coordinate replacements with Dick so they will know the progress with this project.

Also, the snow removal needs to be handled – should be communicated through the trustees.

The committee will meet shortly to assign responsibilities and check on the church facilities to see what needs to be taken care of in the future.

Lenten Bible Study will begin Sunday, February 14, 6 pm at Lakeview. Study will be on Revelation.

**Miscellaneous** - We are planning to have a community wide Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner on February 9, 5-7 pm (at no charge, but with the opportunity for those attending to bring two cans of food to be given to Christ's Kitchen/Food Pantry).

Lakeview's Spring Yard Sale is scheduled for Saturday, April 9. Items may be brought to the church following Easter, March 27.

Next Board meeting will be Tuesday, March 1.

The meeting was closed with prayer by Wayne.
