## ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Bud Newbrough and opened with prayer. Those present in addition to Bud were Pastor Richie, Don Wilson, Karen & Wayne Kersey, Dick & Linda Thompson, Barbara Robinette, Ron Colby, James Rose, and Marilyn Morton. Motion (Don/Wayne) carried to accept the October minutes as printed.

**Treasurer's Report** – The treasurer's report for October was distributed, and motion (Ron/Dick) carried to accept the report. All bills for the month have been paid.

**Finance** – The 2018 Pledge Drive will start on Sunday, November 12<sup>th</sup>. There will be an approx. 2.36% increase in the budget for the 2018 year.

**Trustees** – The project of painting in the multi-purpose room and installing molding is finished, and the next project the trustees will be working on is "doors" ---some of which need to be adjusted.

Also, we are considering having members of the congregation adopt a segment of the bushes on church property and being responsible for trimming and their upkeep.

**Nurture-** Our Thanksgiving Dinner was held on Sunday, the 5<sup>th</sup> and we had 100 persons+ attending. We collected more than 100 cans of food and it was delivered to Christ's Kitchen.

**Family Ministries** – Barbara is researching a play for the youth to present for the Christmas Program.

Plans are to have a covered dish dinner, a play and a 'make & take workshop' where adults can connect with the kids. This will be a "CHRISTMAS FAM JAM" on Sunday December 17<sup>th</sup>, 5:30-7:30 pm.

Children's Church is staffed through the end of the year.

**PS/PRC** – We welcome David Williams as our new pianist.

We checked out an electric piano in our area that we knew to be offered for sale – however, it did not meet our needs, so we are still searching for one for use in our rehearsal/music room.

**Outreach** – To date fourteen Christmas Baskets have been assigned, and we will get the names the week after Thanksgiving. The quilt raffle brought in \$325 which will be used


