ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Kathi McCormick and opened with a reading and prayer. Those present in addition to Kathi were Pastor Richie, Don Wilson, Wayne Kersey and Marilyn Morton. Motion (Wayne/Don) carried to accept the September minutes with the following correction - Under the Treasurer's Report, the monies to be distributed ½ to Humphreys and ½ to Lakeview was to be from the 5K fees rather than 'The Spring Ministry".

(The transaction was completed correctly.)

Treasurer's Report – The treasurer's report for October was distributed, and motion (Don/Wayne) carried to accept the report. All bills for the month have been paid. Also noted that a new washer will be purchased for the Shelter in town from funds that have already been approved for use by Kathi, etc.

Finance - The Finance Committee will meet shortly to approve the budget for next year. Requests have been made for committees to submit their budget needs for next year, we've received our Apportionment figure for next year (which is \$500 less than 2018),

and final details are being submitted for other items to be included.

Nurture - Our Thanksgiving Dinner will be held the first Sunday in November, the 4th at 5 pm. Everyone will be asked to bring a dish to share, plus canned foods to be shared with the local food pantries.

Trustees – A new HVAC has been installed in church and expectation is that heating/cooling costs for next year will be less.

PS/PRC - The committee met and worked on budget numbers for next year. Because of low number of persons attending, the committee will meet again and work out budget numbers.

Family Ministries - Nancy Smith is still recovering from surgery and we are continuing to seek persons to handle the Children's Sunday School Class.

Pastor's Report - Charge Conference will be 3 pm, November 4th at St Paul's Methodist in Nitro.

Noted that we have been having more persons in attendance at church lately.

The Youth Group has started meeting, attendance currently is from four to eight persons.

At the same time let her know if you need heat, air conditioning or kitchen facilities and at what time.


