## ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

### CHURCH CALENDAR

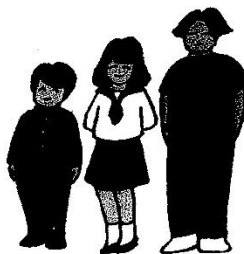
Linda Thompson has the responsibility of keeping the church calendar for managing the facilities of the church.

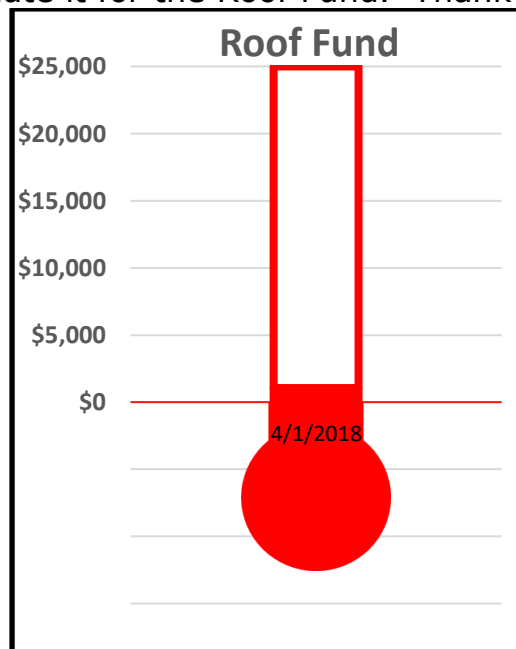
