

ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

Chairperson, Ron Colby called the meeting to order and Mary Ferguson opened the meeting with a reading and prayer. Those present were Pastor Richie, Ron & Marilyn Colby, Franki Noble, Mary Ferguson, Holly Ferguson, Fred McKinney, Jason Black, Bud Newbrough, Dave Ashley and Don & Marilyn Morton. Motion (Bud/Jason) to accept the May minutes as printed.

Nurture – Committee will meet June 23rd. Plans are to have an after church event on July 12.

Treasurer's Report – May was a good income month and we were able to bring our Conference Apportionment payment up to date. The report was accepted as printed.

Finance - The Finance Committee met and discussed options for handling our funds that we keep in reserve for our building fund. The committee recommends that we make two additional payments in June, thus lowering our final debt. However, there still will be a reasonable amount held in reserve to assure that we can meet our monthly obligation. Motion (Bud/Don) passed unanimously that we make two extra payments plus our regular payment in June.

At the meeting, the committee also dealt with the approx. \$1500 remaining from our last yard sale. Recommendation from the committee is to give \$500 to Jericho House, as they are at a critical point at this time in getting their addition ready for use, and to keep the remainder in a fund (to be used toward re-roofing the parsonage and removing the sycamore trees in the parsonage yard). Motion (Dave A. /Fred) carried to follow the committee's recommendations.

Family Ministries/Outreach – There will be a meeting of Vacation Bible School leaders on June 18.

On Sunday evening of VBS (June 28), we will serve hot dogs and smores rather than the ice cream social which we have had in the past.

Robin is looking for donations for food items.

There is still a need for helpers for the week.

Post cards about VBS will be given out at the fishing tournament at the lake this week, and will also be mailed to those who attended last year.

Parsonage – During the recent rain storm, the parsonage had water in the family room. Thanks to those who helped with the clean up. The carpet has been dried and will be reinstalled with new tack strips & padding at a cost of approx. \$200.

A couple of items needing repair will be handled by Dave Ashley.

Trustees – A contributor to causing water to enter the basement of the sanctuary is the outside drain was plugged. We need to make an effort to check both the drains at the outside door of the sanctuary basement and the outside drain at the parsonage to help eliminate a repeat of our experience.
