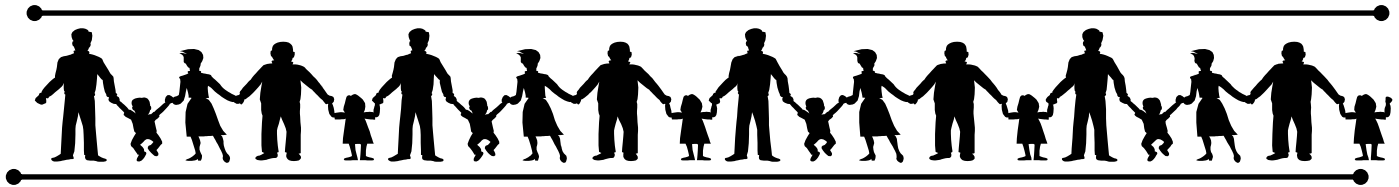

ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Ron Colby, and Bob Carpenter opened the meeting with a meditation and a prayer. Those present were Ron Colby, Pastor Richie, Bud Newbrough, Karen Ekstrom, Jason & Robin Black, Dave Koontz, Dave Ashley, and Don Morton.

After reviewing the minutes, a motion (Bud/Robin) carried to accept the May minutes as printed.

Treasurer's Report – Karen distributed copies of the May Treasurer's report. Conference Apportionment is paid up through May. Motion (Robin/Bud) carried to accept the May report.

Christian Education - Karen Ekstrom reported that Bible School, scheduled for July 11 – 16, will have a 'missions' theme. Plans are well along. She thanked the congregation for the great response in providing leaders and helpers.

Outreach – Outreach is helping with the advertising for Vacation Bible School.

A 'Back to School' event is being planned for sometime in the fall.

Parsonage – Everything is ok at the parsonage.

PS/PRC – PS/PRC and Worship Committee are jointly sponsoring a 'pot luck breakfast' at 9:00 a.m. on June 20 to help celebrate Pastor Richie's Ordination. An all church mailing has been sent giving the details.
