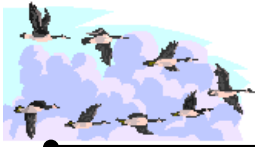

ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Ron Colby, and Wayne Kersey opened the meeting with a devotion. Those present in addition to Ron Colby and Wayne Kersey were Dave Ashley, Marilyn Colby, Karen Kersey, Don Wilson, Dave Koontz, Jeff Ekstrom, and Don & Marilyn Morton.

After reviewing the minutes, a motion (Don M. /Don W.) carried to accept the September minutes as printed.

Finance - We made 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ Conference Apportionment payments this month. However, we are still 1 $\frac{2}{3}$ payment behind for the year.

Cost for ink, paper, etc. to print the new picture directories ourselves was \$360 (less than half of what it would have cost us to contract it out). Motion (Don W. /Karen K.) carried to pay this amount from the church treasury. This money will come from the Cumberledge memorial fund.

Our mortgage has been paid off, and the small amount of "building funds" left over has been applied to our Conference Apportionment.

Treasurer's Report - Motion (Don M./Dave A.) carried to accept the September report. All bills were paid and \$1900 was sent toward our Conference Apportionment.

Fiftieth Anniversary Celebration - We are still on target with plans for the 50th Anniversary celebration later this month.

Family Ministries - Family Ministries met and is currently planning some projects:

- (1) December 11 - dinner and children's play
- (2) December 18 - caroling, followed by returning to the church for snacks
- (3) January 22, 2012 - family dinner, TOOBEEZ (team building)
- (4) February 26, 2012 - family dinner

(5) Women's Tea (date to be worked out with committee)

Parsonage - Thanks to Dave Koontz for repairing the fence in the parsonage backyard

PS/PRC - Lakeview's PS/PRC met and the Lakeview/St. Luke PS/PRC met to develop salary numbers for 2012 for the pastor and other church employees. The Finance Committee has this information to help with their planning.

Trustees - Riverlake Residents covered the cost of repairing the fence in the parsonage backyard (the tree that caused the destruction was from Riverlake property).

New carpet has been installed in the entryway to the education building.

Wayne Kersey has a crew of workers scheduled to wash & wax the multipurpose room floor on Saturday, October 15.

Bill Casto has reminded the trustees that our church is 50 years old; hence the boiler that goes with our heating system is also 50 years old. The trustees will take note.

Worship - November 6th is Communion/All Saints Day.

November 21 - preparation of the sanctuary for Advent

November 27 - First Sunday in Advent

Pastor's Report - Charge Conference is scheduled for 7 pm, November 7th at St. Peters Church.

Miscellaneous - Ron Colby asked for input regarding a planning meeting for 2012. After much discussion regarding dates, time, etc. it was decided that this probably would be best scheduled the beginning of 2012.

Ron Colby also asked for a recommendation from the Finance Committee for the November 8th meeting as to whether we should continue to have one or two yard sales each year, now that our loan has been paid off.

Dave Ashley expressed thanks to Ron Colby for serving as Chairman of the Council.

Meeting was adjourned with prayer by Wayne K.
